at Bird Rescue's Open House in Fairfield
on Saturday, May 11th**

At the open house, visitors will get a chance to see how the local wildlife group cares for the birds, meet the dedicated rehabilitation staff and learn about their work as global leaders in emergency rescue and response.

Tours will be offered throughout the day and a demonstration of how Bird Rescue cleans oiled birds (yes, they really do use Dawn dish soap!). In addition there will be education stations detailing different types of bird diets, teaching about marine debris, and an arts craft table for the kids.
